



MEETING MINUTES JUNE 4, 2007

1. Meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mack Rigby.
2. Guests:
 - a. Harvey Holmes, Metro Chairman – was present to talk about the Rebel shirts that will be presented at the City Championship. Freedom Bass Club members asked Metro not to print Rebel Bass Club on their shirts for Rebel’s 3rd Place win at the 2006 City Championship.
