Scott Saltz-watermelon red brushhogs in 4 to 8 ft water by county ramp/by the dam on second day

Ray Westmoreland-watermelon red senkos/jig in 5ft of water by county ramp

Ron Carter-3/4oz chatterbait and Nichols white/chartreuse spinner bait in 5ft of water in the Mexico side by the dam

Fritz Callier- Big Bass- Rapala 3ft crankbait in 16ft of water in Velenos
