METRO MINUTES  
December 16, 2009

1. Harvey Holmes, Chairman, called the December 16<sup>th</sup>, meeting to order at 7:50 p.m.
2. Roll Call: There were 5 clubs present and 5 absent. Clubs attending were: Freedom, Rebel, SABC, SAPD, and Universal City Bass Club. Clubs not in attendance: Alamo, Helotes, Hill Country Anglers, McArthur HS, and SwRI.
3. Secretary Report: Minutes from the December 2009 meeting were accepted as presented.
4. Treasurer's Report: Metro's financial report was provided by given and accepted. We presently have \$6,527.04 in the account which includes expenses of \$467.00 for the City Championship trophies and a correction of moving the stripper pot into the income column in the amount of \$205.00. (The stripper pot is to be rolled over into the 2010 year, since a stripper was not caught @ Falcon in 2009).
5. Harvey announced that during this meeting we should be nomination officers for the 2010 year. Since no one had been elected or agreed to run for an office, it was decided by those in attendance, that this topic would be tabled until our next meeting, January 20<sup>th</sup>. Harvey did state that if he could get a secretary, then he would more than likely run for Chairman of Metro again.
6. SABC had several members in attendance who expressed an interest in conducting the 2010 Metro City Championship tournament. At this time, SABC announced that Woodie Taylor will be the tournament director for the 2010 City Championship and will work towards a proposal from both Amistad and Falcon Lakes to hold the Metro tournament.
7. The audit for 2009 has not been done as of yet. Ruth Moore, one of the members on the audit committee announced that it will be done by our January 2010 meeting.
8. Harvey went "around the table" and asked the clubs where they had fished or were going to fish. Rebel Bass Club fished Choke Canyon for their club tournament, while Freedom fished Fayette County who experienced icy conditions. SAPD fished Coletto Creek and are headed to Falcon next, while SABC fished Choke where a 12.67# was weighed in. Universal City also recently fished Choke where a club member weighed in 19.96# for 3 fish.
9. Harvey announced that Phil Durocher is going to retire. If anyone is interested in attending Mr. Durocher's retirement, you may get a hold of Harvey or Randi Wayland.
